Technology (Grades 3 - 12)

All parents & students in grades 3 through 12 must read the Technology section of the Student Handbook and submit an electronic Handbook Acknowledgement form (linked in Student Handbook) before a device will be issued or checked-in as follows:

- 8th - 12th grade students who opted to lease laptops* from the school will pick up their laptop(s) at the SMP Campus Commons Area on July 29 or 30 between the hours of 9am and 10am.
- 8th - 12th grade students who will use personal laptops* at school will check-in their laptops at the SMP Campus Commons Area on July 29 or 30 between the hours of 1pm and 2pm. **ALL students must check-in their personal laptop even if it was checked-in a previous year.**
- 5th grade* students will pick up their iPad(s) at the Downtown Campus in the Fine Arts Annex on August 7 (Visiting Day) between the hours of 11:30am and 1:30pm.
- New students in 6th & 7th grade* will pick up iPad(s) at the Downtown Campus in the Fine Arts Annex on August 7 (Visiting Day) between the hours of 11:30am and 1:30pm.
- 3rd & 4th grade* students will be issued their iPads on the first day of class on August 8. Students in these grades will not be allowed to pick up their devices prior to that day.

The following is optional, but requires action before school starts:
